A \$1000 continuing education scholarship provided by the Niizawa Family and SFVJACC Athletics is given to a current or past member of SFVJACC Athletics who has demonstrated scholastic excellence and overcame challenges during their life. The student selected will receive the award to be applied towards his or her college education.

Requirements to qualify:

1. Current or previous member of SFVJACC Athletics (minimum 4 yrs)
2. Student Status
 - Priority given to currently enrolled as a full time college undergraduate or graduate student or entering graduate school in the fall of 2019 or
 - Currently enrolled in a vocational training program or fellowship/internship program or
 - Graduating High School senior entering college fall 2020
3. Include unofficial transcripts.
4. An **OPTIONAL** letter of recommendation must be submitted from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, employer, or community leader who can support your candidacy by addressing your goals orientation, drive and motivation.
5. Interview with scholarship committee (can be arranged via phone or Skype)
6. You may apply in successive years; however you may only receive the scholarship twice.
7. All personal statements will be kept confidential.

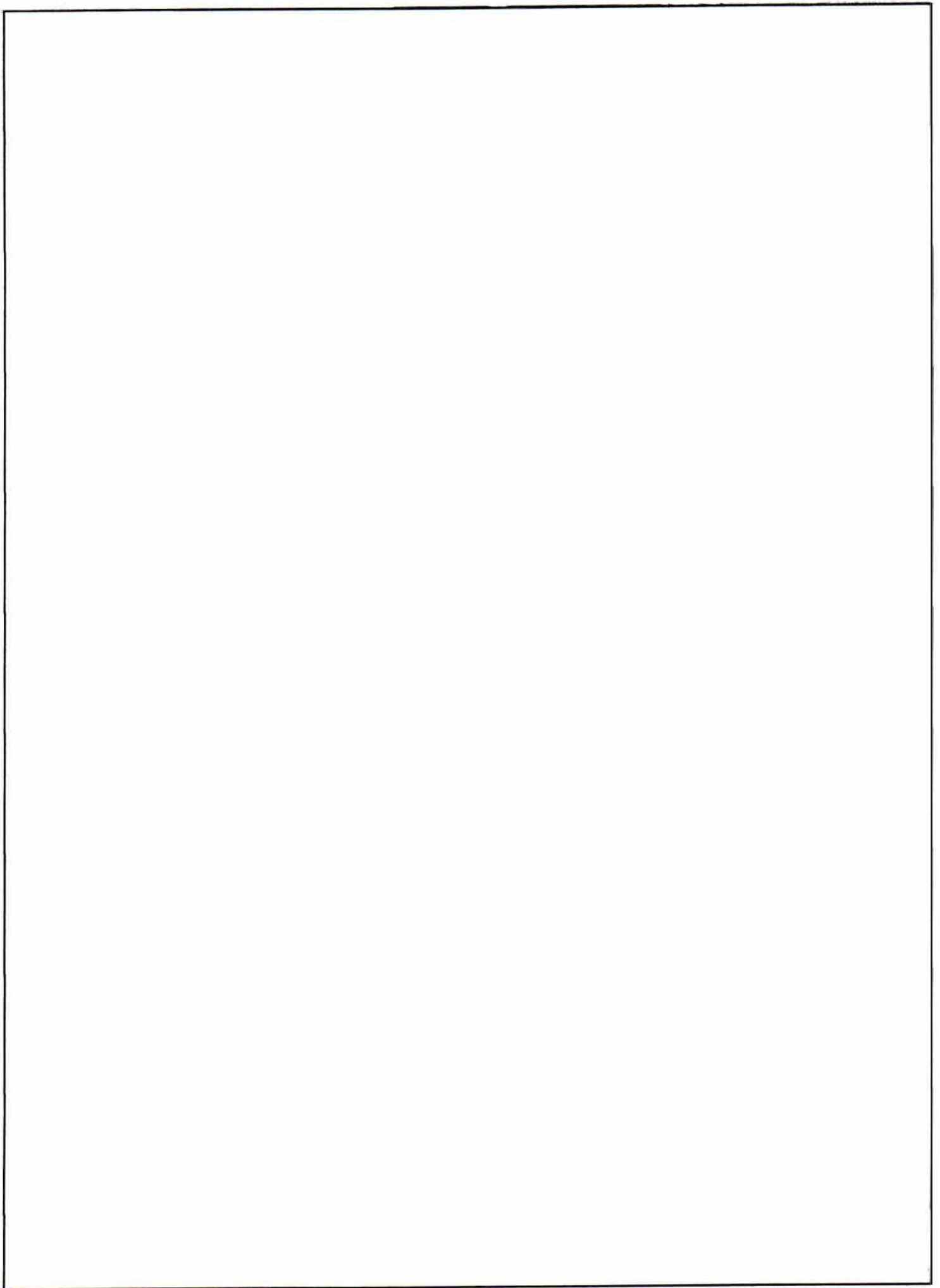
