DIRECTIONS:

1. Answer Application questions either typed or by word processor.
2. Use additional pages as necessary to complete Application Sections “B” through “H”.
 - a. Please label items using Section Title, include letter and caption.
 - b. Please use Times New Roman, 12 point font, double spaced, in the next sections.
 - c. Please write or type on only one side of each page submitted.
3. Transcripts:
 - a. *Entering Freshman* - must include an official, sealed transcript from your high school that includes fall semester grades your senior year.
 - b. *College Student* – must include an official, sealed recent transcript from your college.
 - c. All submitted transcripts must remain sealed to be considered official.
4. SAT and/or ACT scores must be verified, either contained in official transcripts or a copy from the board of test administration.
5. Additional duplicate copies of transcripts for your application are not required.
6. Staple one (1) hard copy photo of yourself to the application (Photo will not be returned).

7. Submit electronically, a short video (2-5 minutes) telling the Scholarship Committee about yourself.
 - a. Accepted Video Formats: AVI, MPEG-4 (.mpg, .mpg2, .mp2, mpg4, mp4)
8. Submit a Video of Performance or Portfolio.
