Requirements to qualify:

- 1. Current or previous member of SFVJACC Athletics (minimum 4 yrs)
- 2. Student Status
 - Priority given to currently enrolled as a full time college undergraduate or graduate student or entering graduate school in the fall of 2024 or
 - Currently enrolled in a vocational training program or fellowship/internship program or
 - Graduating High School senior entering college fall 2024
- 3. Include unofficial transcripts.
- 4. An OPTIONAL letter of recommendation must be submitted from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, employer, or community leader who can support your candidacy by addressing your goals orientation, drive and motivation.
- 5. Interview with scholarship committee (can be arranged via phone or zoom)
- 6. You may apply in successive years; however you may only receive the scholarship twice.
- 7. All personal statements will be kept confidential.
