- Service to schools, community and SFVJACC Athletics
- Minimum of 5 years of SFVJACC Athletics participation as a player
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, community leader
- Essay
- Interview with scholarship committee

Winner will be notified and award will be presented at the SF Jamboree, April 2022 TDB. Winner is encouraged to maintain SFVJACC membership.
